## **2023-2024 School Supplies for Upper School**

### **Middle School Supplies**

**Special Note:** In order to maximize our hallway and classroom space, the width of each student's rolling crate/toolbox should be 24 inches or less. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will only need a rolling backpack because they will not need to bring their math, science, or history textbooks to school.

#### **For School please bring:**

#### **Math 7/6 & Pre-Algebra**

Basic 4-function calculator with square root capability

### **Science**

Yellow Plastic Three-Pronged Folder with pockets  
1 page protector (for lesson plans)  
2 packages lined 3X5 index cards  
7<sup>th</sup> grade only – one 1" binder with 9 tab dividers, and one page protector ( in addition to supplies above)

### **History**

Green Plastic folder with brads and pockets – stocked with notebook paper  
10 page protectors placed in folder  
Composition Notebook (100 pages)  
12-24 count box of colored pencils (erasable recommended)

### **Latin**

1 Composition notebook  
Red plastic folder with brads and pockets  
10 sheet protectors placed in folder

\*Please note – students should keep a stock of notebook paper in each of their folders, except Science. A page protector works well for holding the paper. Folder colors are suggestions to aid in student organization.
