Dear Providence Families,

Today is kick-off day for our **Annual Spring 2026 Skate-A-Thon!**

We encourage you to take a look at the fundraising materials and exciting rewards included in this packet.

The Skate-a-Thon fundraiser is a hands-on opportunity for our families and students to get active together while raising funds that are earmarked for purchasing items to complete our new classrooms and campus. Examples of items that need to be purchased are: Kinder and 1st grade cubbies, upper school and athletic lockers, stage lighting, lower school froggy ball, round event tables, branded sideline seating for the gym, outdoor court striping, and outdoor picnic tables.

This fundraiser is student driven. Our goal is to have fun, get active, encourage fitness, and tell friends and family about our unique school and our kingdom mission.

## Fundraising Packet Details:

**Skate-A-Thon 2026 Activity Tracker:** Students may use the calendar provided to keep track of individual and family fitness activities. (This DOES NOT need to be turned in.)

**Daily Activity Chapel Slips:** Starting Wednesday, February 25th, students will have several opportunities to enter drawings to win prizes during chapel. As students complete goals, they may turn in completed chapel slips for the drawings.

- Students may turn in multiple slips each day.
- The Chapel Slips may be reproduced as needed.
- Additional slips can be found on the school's Skate-a-Thon website.
- There will be multiple drawings each day during chapel.

**Donation Log-** Must be turned in by **8:30 a.m. on March 23rd** to be eligible for prizes.

- **Pledge Amount-** The pledge amount is optional for donors that would like to donate based on the number of laps completed the day of the Skate-A-Thon! *\*\*\*Parents will be responsible for determining their child's skating goal and for counting their laps.\*\*\**
- **Each student** will keep a donation log and envelope for collecting funds.
- Donations split among siblings can be submitted as one single payment, **just be sure to give credit to each student on their donation log.**

**Fundraising-** Fundraising is simple- just reach out to family, friends, and neighbors to tell them all about our school and how much their support means to our future.

**Here are some tips for students:**

- **Make requests in-person or over the phone-** Remember, safety first! Always take a parent or adult with you if you choose to solicit donations in person. Here's some practice language to try out:  

“Hello. My name is \_\_\_\_\_. I go to Providence Academy. We are having our annual Skate-A-Thon event to raise money for our school. The money we raise will be used to fund our new school building. We are raising money together as a school and will celebrate with a fun event on March 24th. Will you support me?”
- **Email or write a letter-** A simple note, letter, or email is a great way to ask for donations. Personal requests are best, however, to help generate some ideas, there is a sample letter included in this packet.
- **Social Media-** Parents with social media accounts can easily spread the word and ask for donations.

## **Skate-a-Thon Day:**

**When:** The Skate-a-Thon will be held off campus at Texas Skatium (2020 Rowlett Rd, Garland, TX 75043) on Tuesday, March 24th from 2:30-4:30.

- Roller skating will be open for 2 hours. During those 2 hours, we'll have fun group activities like the Hokey Pokey, Limbo, races, and more.

**What to Wear:** Students will wear their 2026 Sponsorship Skate-A-Thon t-shirt and *Glow in the Dark* themed accessories to match our Glow and Roll theme. A "Best Dressed" prize will be awarded to one Lower School and one Upper School student.

- Shirts are provided by the school, and ordering information was sent out via email.  
**\*\*Shirt orders are due Tuesday, February 17th.\*\***

**Donations:** Once donations have been fully collected, students may turn in their collection envelopes to the office. To be eligible for prizes, all donations must be turned in by **8:30 a.m. on Monday, March 23rd.**

**Prizes:** Prizes are based individually upon donations raised. They will be distributed all students on **March 23rd.** **\*\*A prize list is included in this packet.\*\***
